

Somalia Rainfall Forecast

Issued: 25 May 2017

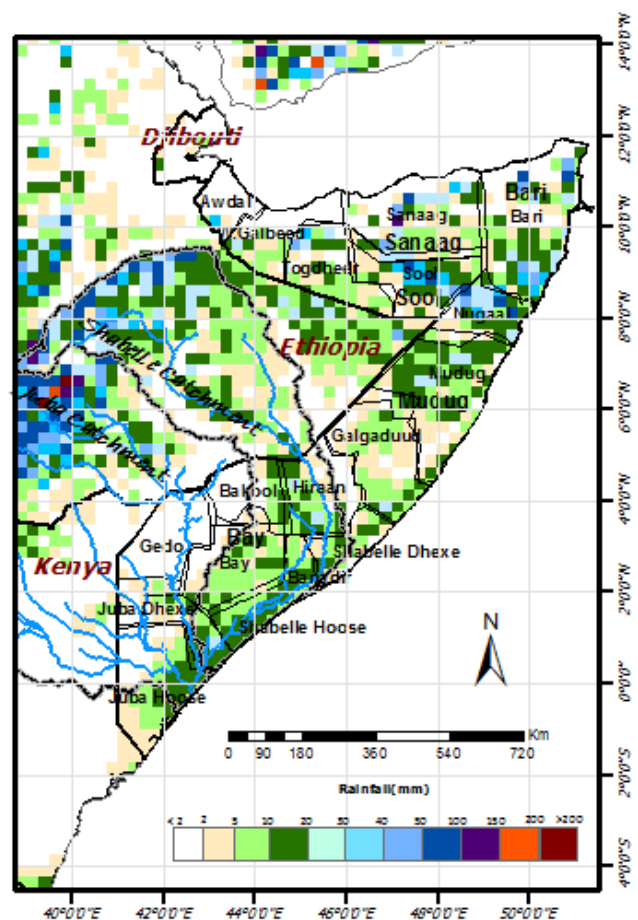
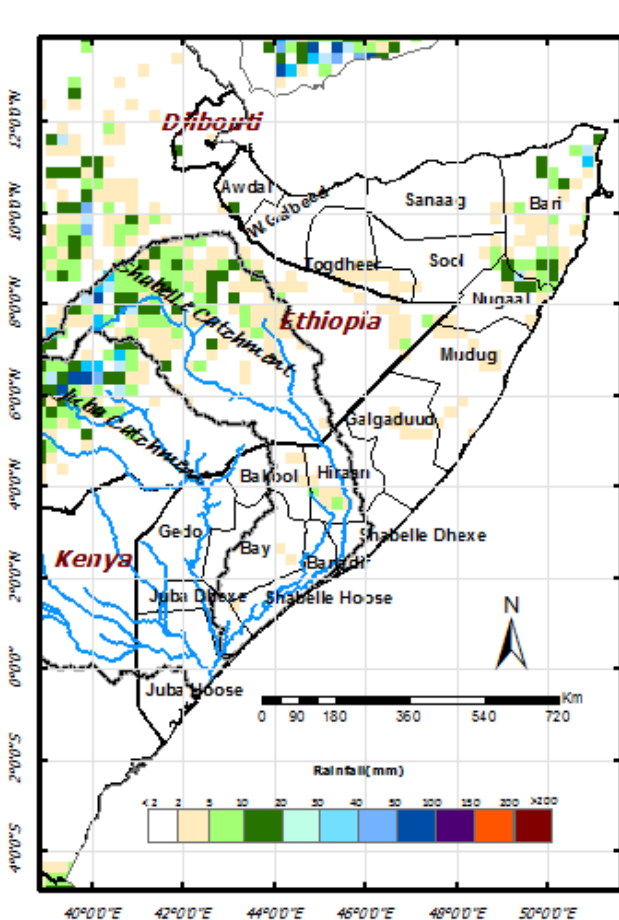
Most parts of Somalia will remain dry for the next three days, apart from few areas in Puntland where light showers are expected (Map 1).

The rainfall forecast for the coming week (Map – 2) is pointing towards light to moderate rains in Puntland and parts of Somaliland. Light rains are also expected in the coastal areas of the Central and South Somalia. The upper parts of Ethiopian highlands are expected to receive moderate rains.

Users are advised that this is a forecast and at times there may be discrepancies between forecast and actual amounts of rainfall received. The forecast, observed river levels and rainfall amounts are updated on a daily basis and can be found on this link: <http://systems.faoso.net/frrims/>
